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2007 Social Survey: Attitudes Towards Municipal & Local Authorities Half of the Population is Satisfied with the Cleanliness in their Neighbourhood

Rate of satisfaction of those aged 20 and over with various characteristics of their residential area:

- * 70% are satisfied with the number of garbage containers.
- * 53% are satisfied with the amount of parks and green spaces: 86% in Modi'in-Maccabim-Re'ut, and 84% in Ra'anana, compared with 42% in Jerusalem.
- * 52% are satisfied with the cleanliness in their residential area: 88% in Ra'anana, compared with 81% in Be'er Sheva.
- * 52% are satisfied with the state of the roads in their residential area.

Approximately one-third of those aged 20 and over applied during the past year for service from their local authority. Of those:

- * 67% received clear and accurate information regarding the service.
- * 66% are satisfied with the attitude of the authority employees.
- * 64% are generally satisfied with the service they received.
- * 39% are unsatisfied with the time spent waiting for the service.

15% used the services of the local community center; 84% of them were satisfied with the variety of activities.
